

# CITY HIGHLIGHTS:

## New Delhi

Chaotic and colorful, New Delhi is full-on sensory overload. The Old Delhi neighborhood is a tangle where people, cows, and rickshaws all share the road. In trendy Haus Khas Village, medieval sites sit next to boutiques, bars, and cool cafes. The capital city and its surrounds have an incredible history, as you can tell from the sheer number of UNESCO World Heritage Sites: the early 13th-century Qutub Minar, a sandstone minaret, the 17th-century Red Fort of the Mughal emperors, and Humayun's Tomb, which inspired the Taj Mahal.

Delhi is also the home for iconic IPL team — Delhi Capitals and their home ground, Arun Jaitley stadium. Delhi has a rich cricket heritage with many iconic players hailing from this city including the champion, Virat Kohli & Virender Sehwag.

# **JAIPUR**

If you take one look at the glorious stucco buildings that line Jaipur's wide streets, you'll understand why this is nicknamed "The Pink City."

The story goes that in 1876, the Prince of Wales visited India on a tour. Since the colour pink was symbolic of hospitality, Maharaja Ram Singh of Jaipur painted the entire city pink. The pink that colours the city makes for a marvellous spectacle to behold. Jaipur rises up majestically against the backdrop of the forts Nahargarh, Jaigarh and Garh Ganesh Temple.

Jaipur holds the distinction of being the first planned city of India. Renowned globally for its coloured gems, the capital city of Rajasthan combines the allure of its ancient history with all the advantages of a metropolis.

Jaipur is also the fort for 1<sup>st</sup> ever IPL champions, Rajasthan Royals and have a rich heritage of producing International cricketers for India.






# **RISHIKESH**


Set against the backdrop of the Himalayas and with the pristine Ganga flowing through it, the ancient town of Rishikesh is one of the major tourist and pilgrimage hubs in northern India. Rishikesh is commonly referred to as the 'yoga capital of the world' and rightly so.

Rishikesh is also known for its connection with The Beatles. In February 1968, members of the legendary English rock band visited Maharishi Mahesh Yogi's ashram (now popularly known as the Beatles Ashram) to learn transcendental meditation.

The new age adventure town of India, Rishikesh also boasts of high adrenaline adventure activities such as River rafting, bungee jumping, swings & ziplines.

Modern Indian batting sensation Rishabh Pant hails from the state of Uttarakhand and started his early playing cricket from here.
